Introduction

Uzhgorod – is the most European city in Ukraine. It is an axiom, coming out of its geographical location, history and mentality. Judge for yourself. Originating late in the 9th century, it has existed for over 20 centuries, and during that time, it has been the territory of a dozen European countries - Kingdom of Hungary, Principality of Transylvania, the Austrian monarchy, Austro-Hungary, the Czechoslovak Republic and Hungary. In 1945, Uzhgorod, the capital of Transcarpathian Ukraine, became part of the Soviet Union. Since 1946, it has been the center of the Transcarpathian Oblast, located in Ukrainian SSR, which later gained its independence in 1991.

Imagine the rich historical heritage, which arose from the influence of so many cultures, that is concentrated in the city. Uzhgorod history is richer than most cities found in even the most historically rich parts of Europe.

The contributions of historical owners and the city were captured in its architecture - Uzhgorod Castle (9-14 c.), the Cathedral and the Bishop’s Palace (16th c.), the streets of the Castle Hill, Via del Corso, Petofo square, Goryanskaya Rotunda (10th c.) Catholic (17 c.) and Reformed churches (18 c.), County parliament building “Zhupanat” (19c.), Synagogue (20 c.), the Regional council and the Galago district (1930 years), some interesting buildings from soviet time. The list of historical monuments would be immensely longer.

Nearly 120,000 people currently live in Uzhgorod. Amongst them are more than 70 nationalities, and a vast variety of religious denominations, which undoubtedly makes it one of the most multicultural cities in Ukraine. Although it is the smallest regional center, it is the only capital of the land which borders with four European Union countries - Hungary, Poland, Romania and Slovakia.

This guide is intended to provide information about places to visit, eat, have fun, and get great service to ensure the most enjoyable experience possible in Uzhgorod. It does not claim to retain ultimate truth. It simply recommends only those which, according to Mercedes-Benz Club Uzhgorod, possess identity, the right level of performance, and quality. In other words - it corresponds to the “mercedes” standard. Guide is published once a year. Each year, its membership can change: someone new can be added but still the old ones can be waned.

Презисловие

Город Ужгород – наиболее европейский город Удрия. Это аслом, исхлдяая из его георафического положеня, исторя, ментальности. Посудите сами. Возникнув в конце 9 века, он за 20 веков своего существования успел побывать в составе десяти европейских государств – королевства Венгрия, княжества Трансильвания, Австрийской монархии, Австро-Венгрии, Чехословацкой республики, Венгрии. С 1945 года, в качестве столицы Закарпатской Удрии, вошел в состав СССР. С 1946 года – центр Закарпатской области Удрийской ССР, которая обрела независимость в 1991 году.

Представяя себе, какое богатое историческое наследие, возникшее под влиянием событий Европы, Вы не найдете много городов, которые бы пережили такую насыщенную историю.

Взгляд исторических исследователей города заставляет и в его архитектуре – Ужгородский замок (9-14 в.), Кафедральный собор и Епископский дворец (16 в.), улицы Замковой Горы, Корзо и Плошья Петефи, Горняцкая Ротонда (10 в.), Католический (17 в.) и Реформатский храмы (18 в.), Комитатская управа «Жупанат» (19 в.), Синагога (20 в.), Земская управа и район Лавтов (1930-е года), здания эпохи социализма, поверье, этот список можно продолжать еще очень долго.

Сегодня в Ужгороде проживает около 120 000 человек более чем 70 национальностей и нескольких десятков религиозных конфессий, что несомненно делает его одним из самых поликультурных городов Удрии. Будучи самым маленьким областным центром, тем не менее, является единственной столицей края, который одновременно граничит с четырьмя государствами ЕС – Венгрией, Польшей, Румынией и Словакией.

Настоящий путеводитель имеет своей целью донести информацию о том, что стоит посмотреть, где стоит остановиться, покушать, всеело провести время или погулять утром. Он не претендует на истину в последней инстанции. Тем не менее, в него вошло только те объекты, которые, по мнению Mercedes-Benz Club Uzhgorod, еще – соответствуют «мерседесовому» стандарту.
